Shame on You, Shame on Me: A Bold Exploration of Societal Conditioning, Gender Norms, and the Evolving Perception of the Female Form**

05.08.2024, Basel, Switzerland – Eleven Ten Studio is proud to present "Shame on You, Shame on Me," an evocative exhibition curated by Aleksandra Cegielska that delves into the intricate facets of societal conditioning, gender norms, and the evolving perception of the female form. This groundbreaking exhibition initiates a vital dialogue on the representation of the female body in art, viewed through the lens of artists deeply immersed in the feminist movement.

"Shame on You, Shame on Me" features a series of provocative artworks by Lucia Fischer, whose pieces prominently highlight nipples and vulvas in gold. Fischer's work challenges viewers to question the societal invisibility and censorship of the female body, particularly within Southeast Asian cultures. She states, "The vilification and objectification of the vulva have been deeply entrenched in patriarchal societies throughout history. Women's sexuality and reproductive abilities have been viewed with suspicion, fear, and disgust, leading to the stigmatization of female genitalia."

Fischer emphasizes that the act of hiding or censoring women's bodies reinforces harmful societal norms, contributing to the marginalization and objectification of women. She critiques the ongoing stigma surrounding the vulva and confronts the historical and cultural baggage associated with it by titling her artworks with an old Latin word for "vulva" that translates directly to "shame." This provocative choice aims to stimulate discussion and promote a more inclusive and affirming view of the female form.

Simultaneously, the exterior and interior of Eleven Ten Studio will showcase large banners by Catherin Schöberl, drawing attention to feminist youth issues. Schöberl's project employs a participatory question-and-answer game, engaging visitors with thought-provoking queries such as, "What would you like to ask your 16-year-old self?" and "How did you see feminism when you were younger? How about today?" This interactive element invites the audience to reflect on their personal journeys and becomes part of the installation.

Join us for the opening on August 8th at 6 pm. The exhibition will run until September 1st, 2024. Eleven Ten Studio invites the public to experience this powerful collection of artworks that challenge and inspire. Regular visiting hours are Wednesday to Friday from 1 pm to 6 pm and Saturdays from 11 am to 4 pm. Special extended hours will be in effect during Kunsttage Basel on August 30th, 31st, and September 1st from 11 am to 6 pm.
